

Youth Advisory Panel

We are excited to announce the formation of a Youth Advisory Panel to sit within the UK Cyber Security Council. The Panel will lead projects, raise awareness of routes into the profession, and provide a youth voice across every part of the Council.

The Youth Advisory Panel will:

- Raise awareness of the Council and cyber security as a career
- o Help develop resources to combat barriers to the profession
- o Lead projects with the Council's support
- o Help create pipelines for young people to work towards Associate status

Panel members will:

- o Receive support provided to enhance personal and professional development
- Represent the voice of young people in cyber security
- o Have a say in the Council's decision making
- o Be part of a cyber security community
- o Help demystify routes into and careers within the profession

Who can apply?

16 to 25-year-olds based in the UK with a passion for cyber security.

Expected commitment

Successful candidates will serve a voluntary position on the Panel from April 2024 to April 2025 with the opportunity to be re-appointed at the end of the term. The role will include meetings and project work and we expect it to be approximately 4-6 hours of their time per month. Members will also attend at least 1 in-person event during the year. For in-person events, the Council will cover any travel and accommodation costs. The Council will also cover the cost of a Basic disclosure check for all Panel members.

Key dates

Applications close at 17:00 on Sunday 18 February. We will invite shortlisted candidates for a video call between 26 February and 5 March and will inform successful candidates by 8 March.
